Day 3

After Breakfast we will be heading to one of the most important Golf Course of Italy: Marco Simone Golf Course Championship Course. In 2022 this course will host the Ryder's Cup.

Designed by Jim Fazio, the 18-hole course covers nearly 247 acres following the classic rounded hills of the Roman countryside. Thanks to the wide variety of tees, each hole can be played from a variety of different points, bringing into play always new obstacles and providing a setting that is ideal for both

beginners and professionals.—Tee time is scheduled for our group.

After Breakfast we will be heading to one of the oldest Golf Course of Italy: Olgiate Golf Course. Located 15 miles north of Rome along the Via Cassia, at the Olgiate, a quiet residential complex, this golf club is

a magnificent classic tree-lined parkland golf course. Opened in 1961, it features 27 holes (18 holes West Course and 9 holes East Course) designed by English architect C. Kenneth Cotton and restyled by architect Jim Fazio in 1996.

During the years it hosted many important international tournaments including the Eisenhower Trophy in 1964, the World Cup on 1968 and 1984, the European Tour Italian Open on 1973 and 2002 (won by Ian Poulter) and the Challenge Tour Roma Open in 2009, 2010 and 2011.

Tee time is scheduled for our group. Lunch will be served at the Golf Course.

Afternoon guided visit of the Vatican and the Sistine Chapel the Masterpiece of Michelangelo.

Dinner tonight at one of the most renowned restaur-

ant of Rome: Gippetto al Portico d'Ottavia.

Day 5 Florence

8:30AM - Depart from Rome Termini Train Station on preassigned, First Class seats, on a High Speed Train, towards Florence (1.30 hours ride). The Rome Termini Train Station (Roma Termini) was built in 1931

and completed in 1950 and is considered a great success both in capability and design.



Evening return, from Florence Santa Maria Novella Train Station (Firenze SMN) opened in 1935 and featuring a spacious entrance hall with a glass and steel roof. Today we will explore the cities of Florence and Orvieto, visiting some of the greatest artistic treasures in the world.

The early breakfast will allow a fantastic day trip to Florence and Orvieto.

Upon arrival walking tour of the city center of Florence with the visit to the amazing Cathedral and the Baptistery, the main Florence Square: Piazza della Signoria and the famous Ponte Vecchio, and finally visit the Accademia with the David's statue.

After an exciting day exploring Florence, we go by bus to the beautiful small town of Orvieto in the hills, for dinner at a gourmet restaurant: Zeppelin. After dinner back to Rome.

Golf Courses general information



Golf Club Marco Simone

Marco Simone Golf and Country Club (also known as **Golf Marco Simone**) is a golf course in Guidonia, Rome, Italy. It is 10 miles from the city centre of Rome and has 2 golf courses, an 18-hole Championship Course and a 9-hole Resort Course. In 2015 it won the bid to host the 2022 Ryder Cup. The golf club was named after the castle of Marco Simone.^[1] The castle was a Roman fortified manor farm. The tower was built approximately in the year 1000 and later in the Middle Ages additional buildings built around it. In the 1970s Laura Biagiotti, the Italian high fashion designer, and her husband Gianni Cigna both lived in the restored castle. By 1989 the golf course had been designed and built. The architects were Jim Fazio and David Mezzacane.^[2] The golf club was the venue of the 1994 Italian Open, which was won by the Argentinian golfer, Eduardo Romero.

Golf Club Olgiata

The course is divided in two areas, the east course and the west course, and a total of 27 holes; it was inaugurated in 1961 and designed by English architect C. Kenneth Cotton. The west course is the oldest of the two and has 18 holes. It has been host to particularly important events, some of which international, such as the Italian Opens of 2002, the 1968 and 1984 editions of the Professional World Team

Championship and numerous other Italian Golf Federation competitions. In 2012, it was almost completely redesigned by American architect Jim Fazio, to fulfil new needs and it is now ready to welcome the International Tournaments; it has three set-ups: PAR 71, 72 and 73, and 7 putts for all categories. The recently-created east course is a 9-hole, par 36 course, 2,947 metres in length. Far from being an executive course, the east course is a true course in its own right, where different competitions and tournaments are played out. **The west course record** is 61 shots (-11), fired during the Italian Opens in 2002 by Ian Poulter (ENG) and Angel Cabrera (ARG)

GOLF CLUB FIUGGI 1928



Golf Club Biella "Le Betulle"

Golf Club Le Betulle - Biella

The prestigious magazine Il Mondo del Golf, over the Top Ten Award 29 years, has ranked this course 18 times first, 6 times second and 4 times third, as well as famous international guides consistently placing it among the top worldwide. Built in the late '50s, the course of Biella Golf Club "Le Betulle" (The Birches) is set in the



charming countryside along the slopes of the Serra moraine, just a few kilometres from Biella and Ivrea. It is provided with any facility, including a Club House with restaurant and guest rooms. The course, an 18 holes parkland , par 73 , 6.534 mt., 7.146 yards, has been designed by the English architect, John Morrison, and it extends in a scenario of rare natural beauty, favouring the morphological characteristics of the ground. It is located at an altitude of 1.936 feet asl. Open every day from April 1st till the end of November. Since many years it has been considered one of the best courses worldwide, both from the domestic and the international press. It is an excellent testing ground for players of every ability.

With the passing of years Golf Club Cavaglia has grown in quality and number of holes. The initial 6-holes were built in 1998, then in 1999 was opened a 9-holes Par 73 with double tees and in 2001 were opened 6 executives holes. In 2014 it has began the work to transform the land into a single golf course Par 68 of 4,600 meters which inaugurated with a Pro Am on April 24, 2015. Golf Club Cavaglia is an excellent base for those who want to organize a golf tour of the best Italian golf courses that are just 45 minutes by car. Golf Club La Mandria - Torino

Torino La Mandria golf club's most important feature is its very location, in the heart of a park, one of the most important lowland forests of the Po river plain, once the Royal House of Savoy's game reserve, where you will also find the famous Reggia di Venaria Reale palace. In the park, among the greens, you'll find the most spectacular natural surroundings for golf in Italy. Torino golf club is entirely built around golf. There are neither roads nor buildings. The features that characterise our two golf courses guarantee two different ways of experiencing the game but what they share are the excellent conditions in which they are maintained, done in a manner that respects the local ecosystem. The environmental policy pursued by the club's directors – achieved through an ecologically sustainable management programme involving the sustainable use of the area and the protection of natural resources – has been awarded the Impegnati nel Verde award.
