Entry Requirements to Dubai

- A **negative PCR test** taken **no more than 72h** before departure
- Children under the age of 12 and passengers who have a moderate or severe disability are exempt from taking a COVID-19 PCR test.
- We highly recommend to travel with insurance that covers covid 19 expenses

Entry Requirements to Egypt

To enter Egypt it is mandatory to present ONE of the following options:

- A negative PCR test certificate with a QR code issued a max. of 72h prior departure
- A **negative PCR** test certificate with the **laboratory seal** stamped issued a **max. of 72h** prior departure
- A Vaccination Certificate with a QR code a min. of 14 days after the second dose. Please, note that NOT all airlines accept the vaccination certificate to travel; We recommend to check with your airline before traveling.
- We highly recommend to travel with insurance that covers covid 19 expenses

NOTE. Please bear in mind that upon arrival at the airport in Egypt, passengers must take an ID test (rapid covid -19 test) and in case of positive they will not be able to enter the country. The test is carried out at the same airport and does not replace the negative PCR test that they must bring from their countries. The cost of the ID test is US \$ 65.00 (equivalent to EGP 1000.00) and must be paid by the passenger in the Quarantine Section at the airport.
